
2024 Alcohol Awareness PSA Contest Winners Announced!

Current 7th Grade Course Recommendations

Hello 7th Grade Parents

Your child's current academic teachers have completed the teacher recommendations process for the upcoming school year. As of friday, April 19, you and your child can view this information by logging into the parent or student portal. Click on the Course Request tab to view the information.

If you have any questions regarding honors placement or teacher recommendations, please contact the teacher directly. If there are any errors in your child's course requests, or if you have any questions regarding your child's academic plan, please contact Mrs. Katie Lasso, School Counselor at

If your child has an IEP, please feel free to reach out to your child's case manager with any questions. Special Education schedules will be finalized during IEP meetings.

Lunch, PE8/Health and the cycle elective classes (Art, DMR, Intro to Computer Technology, and Spanish) have been added as well. Your child's full year elective course will be rolled over to the following year (Band, Chorus, or Band and Chorus). The Kaleidoscope class has been rolled over as well.

If your child is currently enrolled in the DMR 7 full year elective course, they will be rolled over into STEAM 8. The course description is listed below for your review. DMR 8 has been added to the eighth grade elective cycle.

STEAM 8 Course Description
The 8th grade STEAM program focuses on design and problem-solving techniques. During this full year elective course, students will explore various themes such as transportation, computer design, structures, and safety. They will learn about various STEAM vocations, the five areas of STEAM, and the importance of technology throughout history. Projects that will be explored, and which can change at any time, include the following: Earthquake Towers, Catapult, Parachutes, Balloon Powered Cars, Pasta Structures, and other problem-solving projects.

Tentative schedules will be available in mid to late August. Your child will receive their official schedule on the 1st day of school which is scheduled for Tuesday, September 3, 2024.

Please keep in mind that we do not accept requests for specific teachers or class sections.



- Outstanding Fees: Once on the Parent Portal, scroll down under Menu and click on "Fines." If your child has an outstanding obligation, it will be displayed on the "Fines" page.
- Negative Cafeteria Balances: Once on the Parent Portal under Menu, click on "Food Services" to view your child's account. If your child has a negative cafeteria balance, you have been receiving weekly notifications on the amount due.

You can either send in a check made payable to KRHS for the outstanding obligation or pay online with PaySchools Central @ https://payschoolscentral.com/.
